# Admission rules in credit system

## **As per Circular No.UG/ 02 of 2012-2013**

### **ARTS:**

### 1. SYBA / SYBMM (Semester III)

Student should have cleared both Semester I & Semester II (grade E or higher)

OR

Student should have not more than 4 F in Semesters I & II together & not more than 2 in each of the semesters

### 2. TYBA / TYBMM (Semester V)

Student should have cleared Semesters I, II, III & IV (grade E or higher)

OR

Student should have cleared Semesters I & II (grade E or higher) and should have not more than 4 F in Semesters III & IV together & not more than 2 in each of the Semesters III & IV OR

Student should have cleared Semesters III & IV (grade E or higher) and should have not more than 4 F in Semesters I & II together & not more than 2 in each of the Semesters I & IV

### **SCIENCE:**

#### 1. SYBSc

Student should have cleared both Semester I & Semester II (grade E or higher)

OR

Student should have not more than 4 F in Semesters I & II together & not more than 2 in each of the semesters where total marks are less than 900

OR

Student should have not more than 6 F in Semesters I & II together & not more than 3 in each of the semesters where total marks are 900 or more

#### 2. TYBSc

Student should have cleared all Semesters [I, II, III & IV (grade E or higher)]

OR

Student should have cleared Semesters I & II (grade E or higher) and should have not more than 4 F in Semesters III & IV together & not more than 2 in each of the Semesters III & IV where total marks are less than 900

OR

Student should have cleared Semesters III & IV (grade E or higher) and should have not more than 4 F in Semesters I & II together & not more than 2 in each of the Semesters I & II where total marks are less than 900

OR

Student should have cleared Semesters I & II (grade E or higher) and should have not more than 6 F in Semesters III & IV together & not more than 3 in each of the Semesters III & IV where total marks are 900 or more

OR

Student should have cleared Semesters III & IV (grade E or higher) and should have not more than 6 F in Semesters I & II together & not more than 3 in each of the Semesters I & II where total marks are 900 or more
