Dear Parents,

As you are aware about the pandemic situation of COVID-19 across the world and now a couple of cases identified in Maharashtra and Mumbai as well, the School Management, as a precautionary measure, has decided to keep the school closed from Monday, 16<sup>th</sup> of March to Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020. All classes and activities will be suspended during this period.

The only exceptions to the rule will be the students who are coming to give their ICSE Board exams. The ICSE Board examination will continue as scheduled. Students are expected to follow the schedule already given by the ICSE Council.

However, even though students will not be physically present in School, we will continue teaching by moving onto online platforms. Teachers will conduct their lessons on a regular basis, sharing presentations, videos, and other resources on WhatsApp, based on which students will be assessed on their return to School. In addition, they will also be given assignments that they will be expected to complete. Please note that none of the lessons taught during this period will be revisited

I take this opportunity to reassure all parents that necessary precautionary measures have been taken in School to keep your children safe when school re-opens.

The School will keep you updated about their academic planning and timelines through e-mails and the school website.
