Sub: New Initiatives at the ICSE and ISC Examination Levels

The Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations is pleased to share the following new initiatives that have been introduced at the ICSE and ISC Examination levels:

ICSE

From the Examination Year 2020 onwards, for the subjects that have more than one paper, candidates will be able to apply for recheck of their individual papers instead of applying for recheck of the subject as a whole. For e.g. for the subject Science, the candidates will have the option of applying for recheck individually, for Physics, Chemistry or Biology. The same applies for the subjects English and History, Civics and Geography.

ISC

In keeping with the pattern followed in majority of the subjects at the ISC level, a component of Project Work carrying 20 Marks has been introduced for the subjects English, Mathematics and Indian Languages. The Theory examination will hence carry 80 Marks. **This change will be applicable from the Examination Year 2022 onwards.**
